Of Italian and English descent, former poet-turned-acoustic singer/songwriter Jack Savoretti's top ten album "Written in the Scars" made him a star with a sell-out worldwide tour to follow.

Since re-emerging on the UK live scene 2015, Jack has been selling out venues and captivating audiences across the country. His latest album "Sleep No More" showcases a more playful side to Jack's dirty romantic sounds and heads towards being his second Gold album. The versatile performer



can swing from slick rock to autumnal folk flawlessly.

Jack continues to cement his reputation as one of the UK's standout male singer/ songwriters with performances on Graham Norton, Strictly Come Dancing and The One Show. Having sold an astonishing 50,000 tickets in the past year across the UK the rest of 2017 has plenty more in-store as Jack has been invited by John Legend as a special guest to open his UK and European arena tour in late 2017.


