SIR BRYN TERFEL & HANNAH STONE



We are thrilled to welcome back opera superstar Sir Bryn Terfel. As one of the world's most sought after singers, this year he is accompanied by harpist, Hannah Stone to make his long-awaited return to Belmond Le Manoir. His incredible presence on stage, phenomenal voice and his overflowing personality all contribute to his breathtaking performances.

Welsh bass-baritone **Sir Bryn Terfel** has established an extraordinary career, performing regularly on the prestigious concert stages and opera houses of the World, including the Royal Opera House, Covent Garden; the Metropolitan Opera, New York; Opéra National de Paris; Teatro Alla Scala and Zürich Opera. Roles for which he is most noted include *Falstaff*, *Dulcamara*, *Wotan* and *Holländer*. Recent additions to his repertoire include *Reb Tevye*, *Boris Godunov* and *Sweeney Todd*.

An acclaimed recitalist, he is equally renowned for his versatility as a concert performer with highlights ranging from the opening ceremony of the Wales Millennium Centre, BBC Last Night of the Proms, and the Royal Variety Show to a Gala Concert with Andrea Bocelli in Central Park. New York.

Hannah Stone, former Harpist to H.R.H. the Prince of Wales, studied at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama. London where she gained a B.Mus. and M.Mus. degree. During her studies. Hannah was selected to represent the Guildhall School in collaboration with the Academies Festival Orchestra, Singapore, This project culminated in an opening gala performance for the Singapore Sun Festival at the Esplanade Theatre with Dame Kiri te Kanawa. In 2010 Hannah returned to Wales to further her studies at the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama. Cardiff, supported by the Victor Salvi Scholarship and graduated in 2012.

Hannah has performed at many notable venues including the Barbican Centre, LSO St Luke's, St John's Smith Square, Museum of London, National Concert Hall in Dublin, St David's Hall and the Wales Millennium Centre in Cardiff. In 2010 Hannah was appointed principal harpist with the Schleswig Holstein Festival Orchestra touring Europe. She has performed as guest soloist with orchestras including the BBC National Orchestra of Wales, Sinfonia Cymru, RTÉ Concert Orchestra, English Chamber Orchestra and Borusan Philharmonic Orchestra. Istanbul.

THE PERFORMANCE WEDNESDAY 3RD OCTOBER IMELDA MAY

If you don't know Imelda May, prepare to be blown away. If you are already a fan, get ready to hear her as you never have before.

She has found a new groove, exploring blues, soul, gospel, folk, rock, sensitive acoustica, cinematic drama and explosive balladry on a set of the boldest, most personal and intimately autobiographical songs she has ever written. Long celebrated by peers as one of the most sensational singers of contemporary music, Imelda May has made the album of her life "Life Love Flesh Blood".

Her musical range is breathtaking, from the classic fifties rock and soul melodrama of bitter ballad *Black Tears* to the slinky, sensuous *How Bad Can A Good Girl Be?* Imelda knew before she had even begun work on Life Love Flesh Blood that it was time for a change of musical direction. "I love the rawness of rockabilly but it's just one of the many

musics that inspired me. I also love my punk, blues and jazz and it was always mixed in there." Her 2014 album *Tribal*, she says "meant a lot to me because I knew I had got to the end of that road. I wanted to go as far as I could, so that I could step away from it." It was her highest chart topping album worldwide, going to number one in Ireland, and top three in the UK.

Such stellar talents don't congregate by chance. Imelda's reputation as a vocalist can be deduced from the company she keeps, performing over the years with Lou Reed, Smokey Robinson, Tom Jones, Meat Loaf, David Gilmore, Sinead O'Connor, Wanda Jackson, Lulu, Paolo Nutini, The Dubliners, The Chieftains, U2, Robert Plant and many more.
